Local Plan Consultation and Lodge Farm

There are now less than two weeks until the consultation **closes on Monday, 19 May**. The outcome will influence which sites are allocated for building homes in Rugby Borough and it is very important that Lodge Farm is not one of them - a housing estate of 2,650 homes one field away from Willoughby, up to 25,000 extra vehicle trips per day on the A45, devastating harm to the landscape and environment of the Leam and Rainsbrook Valleys.

Stand Against Lodge Farm (SALFV) has drawn up three letters of objection on the following grounds:

1. Transport Infrastructure, Traffic and Safety
2. Environmental and Landscape Harm
3. Community Sustainability and Infrastructure

And, a Willoughby resident has provided a fourth letter objecting on the grounds of

4. Harm to the Historic Environment

Many residents have already signed the letters and their family, friends and neighbours are signing as well.

Every signature matters.
